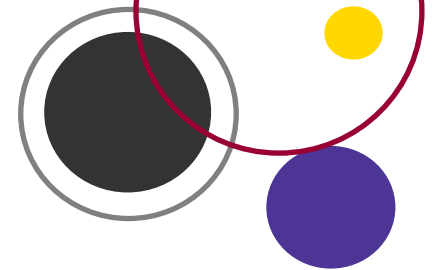
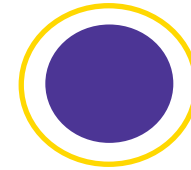
The Light Up Bellevue Fund is a Designated Fund of the Bellevue Community Foundation (BCF).

- In order to be respectful to the neighbors around the Park, this music and light show will end promptly at 10 PM each evening.
